They have been missed for decades. The wall reflects the sun and the SON. It has already brought healing to one family. After seeing the monument, the father admitted his guilt in requesting his wife have an abortion years ago.

Seeing his child's name broke his spirit and he admitted he was wrong.

And recently a young father was riding his bicycle by the Memorial and was overcome by what we are doing there. He stopped took down the phone number for Christians for life and

called Barbara Saldivar. He and his girlfriend just lost a baby girl and wanted to know if they could put her name on the wall. Barbara sent him a letter assuring them we would be honored to put their baby's name on the monument.

The cement footings for the light posts have been poured. Our next steps are to put in the city water meter. Install the lighting. Build the walks to the wall. Do landscaping and underground water system.

The vision that the Lord gave us six years ago is taking form right before our eyes. It is exciting and humbling. So many have given so much to see this memorial come

to life.

Many have sacrificed long, back breaking work to clear the land. To mow and plant flowers.
