In May ground was broken for the memorial. The property was graded and a road cut on the east side of the land. Volunteers then cut up trees that had been removed and the wood was given to anyone that wanted it. It is an exciting time for those of us that have visualized the memorial wall for over six years. We are moving ahead with the first phase of the memorial...the wall. The wall will be black granite. We have already heard from many who want the names of their unborn babies placed on the wall. The path to the wall will be paved with bricks that have been donated by supporters who want to create the "healing path to the memorial wall." As individuals take the walk to the wall they will see the names of those who helped make the memorial a reality.

At this writing a native stone retaining wall is being built east of the Memorial wall. The retaining wall will cost between \$12 and \$15,000.00. The memorial granite plus 50 names engraved on it will be \$9,500.00. **WE REALLY NEED your financial support ASAP** so that the Heart of
