Sunday September 13, 2015 was the first annual **S.A.F.E. SUNDAY.**

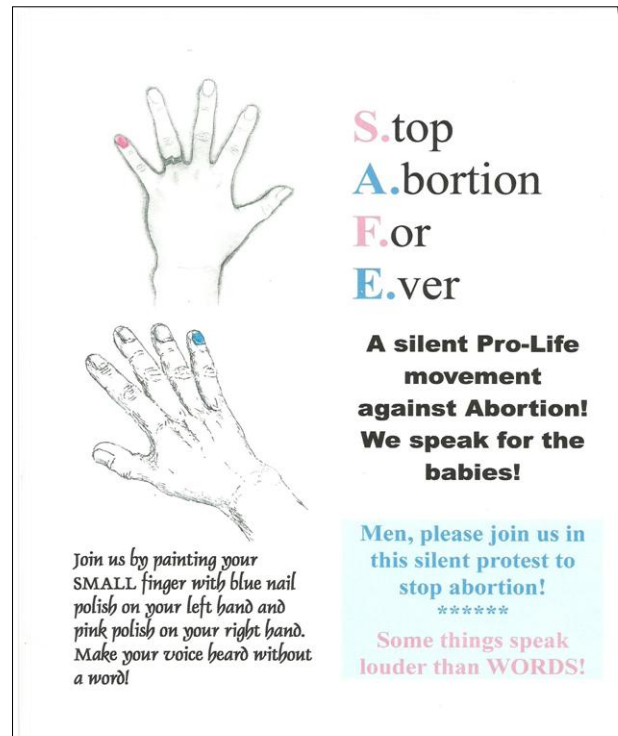
