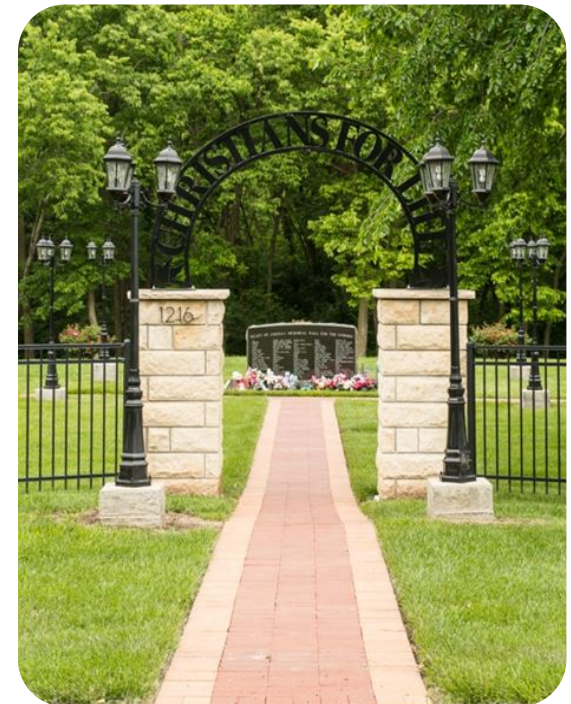

Miscarriage

In Miscarriage, often only the mother and perhaps the father, even knows of the loss of the baby. There is no public recognition of the child's life and its loss, and this leaves a void in the grieving process. The Memorial Wall is a place to proclaim and give a name to a life, even if it was brief.

Stillbirth

It was Dec. 23, when I found out that the baby inside my womb was dead and I would go into labor whenever my body was ready to deliver. So, I went home and waited and cried, hoping each movement inside of me, would bring the labor on. The word "stillborn" was very foreign to me. My husband and I will always remember the snowy day in January, when we laid her to rest. Forty years later, I still think of her and how she would have fit in with her brothers. I have learned to not ask WHY, but I'm so glad that she is in Heaven with so many other babies.

Abortion

There are many steps in the process of healing for women and men that have had or participated in an abortion. When repentance comes, the desire to make amends needs an outlet. The memorial wall is a place where God is honored as the names are placed on it. Recognizing the life that was lost and honoring them by placing a name on the wall is a major step in post-abortion healing.
